### **WARRENVILLE POLICE ARREST AURORA MAN FOR FALSE PERSONATION OF A PEACE OFFICER**

WARRENVILLE, IL – On April 21, 2018, at about 2:06 p.m., the Warrenville Police Department received a 911 call of a subject driving a newer model yellow Camaro, who tried to pull the caller over in the area of IL Route 56 and Winfield Road. After a short period of time, the two vehicles ended up going in separate directions.

Police initiated an investigation into this incident. During the investigation, the victim described the driver of the yellow Camaro as a male white in his 50's, with short salt & pepper hair and facial hair. The victim further stated the driver of the Camaro displayed a gold colored badge and pointed with his hand at the victim to pull over.

The driver of the Camaro was later identified as Jeffrey M. Spiewak (pictured below), 56, of the 3000 block of Anton Drive, Aurora, Illinois.

On May 9, 2018, Detectives obtained a complaint and arrest warrant for Spiewak for one felony count of False Personation of a Peace Officer, and one misdemeanor count of Disorderly Conduct. Spiewak, whose bond was set at \$20,000, was taken into custody without incident and transported to the DuPage County jail.
