5. CARGO CONTAINERS

Cargo containers, temporary membrane structures, storage tents and temporary storage canopies may be placed on a private property not more than four (4) times, for a total of thirty (30) days in any one calendar year. Notwithstanding the foregoing restriction, the City of Warrenville Chief Building Official may extend the length of time a cargo container, temporary membrane structure, storage tent or temporary storage canopy can remain on private property to a maximum of 120 days provided the cargo container, temporary membrane structure, storage tent or temporary storage canopy is located on a property that has a valid building permit for a major construction project and is used to store construction equipment, construction materials, and/or relocated personal possessions. Cargo containers, temporary membrane structures, storage tents and temporary storage canopies shall not be located in required interior side or rear yard setbacks. A permit from the City of Warrenville Community Development Department is required to place temporary cargo containers, temporary membrane structures, storage tents, and temporary storage canopies on a private property.
