WARRENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATES IN SPECIAL OLYMPICS ILLINOIS COP ON ROOFTOP AND TORCH RUN FUNDRAISER EVENTS

Warrenville, IL – On Friday, May 30, 2014, from 5:00 a.m. through 2:00 p.m., Police Officers from the City of Warrenville will participate in the statewide fundraising event to benefit the Illinois Special Olympics. For the second time, the 12-year old event will be held in Warrenville at the *Dunkin' Donuts, located at 2 S 721 IL RT 59.*

Officers around the State will sit on a record breaking 170 Dunkin' Donuts rooftop locations in hopes to heighten awareness and raise money for the Illinois Special Olympics athletes.
