Two Charged in Warrenville Armed Robbery

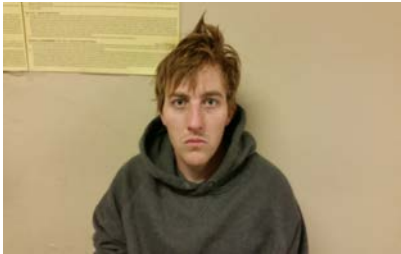
WARRENVILLE, IL – On Monday, February 23, 2015, at approximately 10:03 a.m., a male white entered the Mobil gas station, 28W050 Warrenville Road, displayed a handgun, and demanded cash from the cashier. After obtaining U.S. currency, the offender fled the scene in a late model, white two-door vehicle being driven by a female white.

Warrenville Police detectives immediately began investigating the incident and developed two suspects. The information regarding these suspects was disseminated to other police departments in the Chicago vicinity.

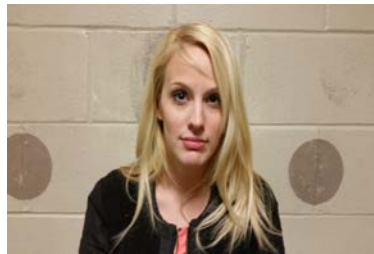
On Tuesday, February 24, 2015, at approximately 3:00 p.m., an Elk Grove Village police officer spotted the suspect vehicle in a motel parking lot. A short time later, the suspects were observed exiting their motel room and loading belongings into the trunk of their vehicle. At that time, they were taken into custody without incident. The suspects are identified as Jason A. J. DeVincent, 29-years old, last known address in the 500 block of Stewart Street, Batavia, Illinois; and Amanda A. Hicks, 28-years old, last known address on Brendon Court, Roselle, Illinois.

DeVincent and Hicks were both charged with one count each of Aggravated Robbery, a class-one felony, and are being held at the DuPage County Jail. DeVincent is being held without bond, while Hicks' bond was set at \$150,000.
