## **WARRENVILLE POLICE ARREST TWO IN SHOTS FIRED INCIDENT**

Warrenville, IL – On Saturday, November 3, 2012, at approximately 1:29 a.m., Warrenville Police Officers responded to a report of gunshots fired in the 500 block of Winchester Circle North. In responding to the incident, Police Officers stopped a vehicle leaving the area; subsequently, two subjects were taken into custody, and one firearm was recovered. A police canvas of the area confirmed that no injuries were sustained as a result of the shots being fired.

The two subjects who were taken into custody have been arrested in connection with this incident. Adrian Ramos, 21-years of age, who resides at 365 N. Union Street, Aurora, Illinois, will be charged with Reckless Discharge of a Firearm, and Possession of a Firearm Without Requisite Firearms Owners Card. David Vargas, 20-years of age, who resides at 1088 Lisa Boulevard, Aurora, Illinois, was charged with Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of a Firearm Without Requisite Firearms Owners Card. Vargas was transported to the DuPage County Jail, and awaits his bond court date of November 4, 2012.

During subsequent investigation, Warrenville Police Detectives were assisted by members of the West Chicago Police Department, DuPage County Sheriff's Office, and the DuPage County State's Attorney's Office.
