WARRENVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PARTICIPATES IN SPECIAL OLYMPICS ILLINOIS COP ON ROOFTOP FUNDRAISER

Warrenville, IL – On Friday, May 31, 2013, from 5:00 a.m. through 2:00 p.m., Police Officers from the City of Warrenville will participate in the statewide fundraising event to benefit the Illinois Special Olympics.

For the first time, the 11-year old event will be held in Warrenville at the newly opened *Dunkin' Donuts, located at 2 S 721 IL RT 59*. Officers around the state will sit on a record breaking 150 Dunkin' Donuts rooftop locations in hopes to heighten awareness and raise money for the Illinois Special Olympics athletes.
