NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR APRIL 6, 2021 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION AVAILABLE AT CITY HALL

WARRENVILLE, IL – Nominating petitions for anyone wishing to run for office for the Consolidated Election to be held Tuesday, April 6, 2021, will be available at City Hall, 3S258 Manning Avenue, Warrenville, Illinois, during regular office hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and on the City website, www.warrenville.il.us/322/Elections, on and after September 18, 2020.

Offices to be elected at the Consolidated Election are as follows: One (1) Mayor, One (1) City Clerk, One (1) City Treasurer, and One (1) Alderman from each of Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3, and Ward 4; each office to serve a four (4) year term to expire April 30, 2025. Independent candidates seeking election at the April 6, 2021, Consolidated Election may circulate nomination papers no earlier than September 22, 2020.

Nominating Petitions must be filed with the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk at City Hall during normal business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The first day to file nominating papers is December 14, 2020. The last day to file is December 21, 2020. A current receipt for filing a statement of economic interest with the DuPage County Clerk must be included with submitted

petitions no later than 5:00 p.m., December 21, 2020. Objections to nominating petitions may be filed until December 30, 2020.

Position on the ballot will be determined by when the nominating papers are filed with the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk. If more than one candidate files simultaneously for the same office, a lottery will be held on December 30, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. to determine ballot placement.
