


# Master Pedestrian System - Exhibit F



**Legend:**


- — — — — 5' Wide Concrete Sidewalk

Notes  
 This plan reflects a minimum level of improvement for pedestrian and bicycle movement. This approach reflects current norms in suburban development, which has been widely criticized for its reliance on automobile transportation, and efforts are underway to reduce this dependency. One way to accomplish this is to encourage pedestrian and bicycle use. The success of such efforts is difficult to predict and building unused trails and sidewalks is not in anyone's interest. However, without making the effort to facilitate wider pedestrian/bicycle movement, this activity will not be possible. The best approach would be to make incremental improvements as development occurs and demands can be more accurately assessed.
