## **NOTICE OF EXPUNGEMENT**

To Whom it may Concern:

The Illinois Juvenile Court Act (705 ILCS 405/1-1 *et seq.*, the “*Act*”), Section 5-915, provides that on or before January first of each year, law enforcement agencies in the State of Illinois must review their records and automatically expunge those records involving minors under the age of 18. Expunged law enforcement records must meet certain criteria set forth in the Act.

Section 5-923 of the Act also requires a law enforcement agency engaged in the automatic expungement process provide notice to an individual who was a minor under the age of 18 involved in an incident or matter documented in a law enforcement record when that record is expunged. The Act defines “Expunge” as follows:

Section 1-3: "Expunge" means to physically destroy the records and to obliterate the minor's name and juvenile court records from any official index, public record, or electronic database.

In accordance with Section 5-923 of the Act, you are hereby notified that the City of Warrenville Police Department automatically expunged a law enforcement record of an incident or matter that occurred prior to your eighteenth birthday that may have included information about you.

Additional information regarding automatic expungement may be found by reviewing the Act itself or by consulting your attorney.
